ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL

This is an appeal from a district court order granting a motion to review and procure credit for time served. Eighth Judicial District Court, Clark County; Susan Johnson, Judge.

On July 6, 2016, this court entered an order directing counsel for appellant to show cause why this appeal should not be dismissed for lack of jurisdiction. Counsel has responded to our order and concedes that no statute or court rule provides for an appeal from an order granting a motion to review and procure credit for time served. *See Castillo v.
