## ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL

This is a proper person appeal from an order of the district court denying appellant's motion to correct an illegal sentence. Our review of this appeal indicates that the district court entered the order denying appellant's motion on September 15, 2000. Appellant did not file the notice of appeal, however, until December 11, 2000, well after the expiration of the thirty-day appeal period prescribed by NRAP 4(b). An untimely notice of appeal fails to vest jurisdiction in this court. <u>See</u> Lozada v. State, 110 Nev. 349, 871 P.2d 944 (1994). Accordingly, we conclude that we lack jurisdiction to consider this appeal, and we
