ORDER OF AFFIRMANCE

Appellant Cyrus E. Parssi appeals from a judgment of conviction, pursuant to a jury verdict, of break, injure, or tamper with a motor vehicle. Eighth Judicial District Court, Clark County; Susan Johnson, Judge.

Parssi argues there was insufficient evidence to support the jury's finding of guilt because the evidence did not establish when the vehicle was scratched. Our review of the record on appeal, however, reveals sufficient evidence to establish guilt beyond a reasonable doubt as determined by a rational trier of fact. *See Origel-Candido v. State*, 114 Nev. 378, 381, 956 P.2d 1378, 1380 (1998); *see also Jackson v. Virginia*, 443 U.S. 307, 319 (1979).

A witness testified she was in a parking lot when she noticed Parssi was angry because a vehicle was parked too close to his car. That witness testified she noticed the vehicle did not have any scratches and looked as if it was new. She then saw Parssi using an object to scratch the side of the vehicle. Based upon the testimony presented at trial, we conclude the jury could reasonably find Parssi willfully broke, injured, or tampered with the vehicle for the purpose of injuring, defacing or

destroying that vehicle. See NRS 205.274(1). It is for the jury to determine the weight and credibility to give conflicting testimony, and the jury's verdict will not be disturbed on appeal where, as here, substantial evidence supports the verdict. See *Bolden v. State*, 97 Nev. 71, 73, 624 P.2d 20, 20 (1981); see also *McNair v. State*, 108 Nev. 53, 56, 825 P.2d 571, 573 (1992). Accordingly, we

ORDER the judgment of conviction AFFIRMED.
