ORDER DENYING PETITION FOR

WRIT OF CERTIORARI, MANDAMUS, OR PROHIBITION


This is an original petition for a writ of certiorari, mandamus, or prohibition challenging the district court's order imposing sanctions against petitioners for violating SCR 182. We have considered the petition, and we are not satisfied that this court's intervention by way of extraordinary relief is warranted.<sup>1</sup>


<sup>1</sup>See NRS 34.020(2) (authorizing issuance of a writ of certiorari in civil cases only when an inferior tribunal, board, or officer has exercised judicial functions beyond jurisdictional limits); NRS 34.320 (limiting a writ of prohibition to proceedings in excess of the jurisdiction of a tribunal, corporation, board or person exercising judicial functions); Round Hill Gen. Imp. Dist. v. Newman, 97 Nev. 601, 637 P.2d 534 (1981) (stating that a writ of mandamus will not lie to control discretionary action unless discretion is manifestly abused or exercised in an arbitrary or capricious fashion).

Accordingly, we deny the petition.<sup>2</sup> The motion to extend the district court's stay is denied as moot.
