ORDER DENYING PETITION

This petition challenges the refusal of the respondent district court to accept petitioner's admission to one count of use of a controlled substance in a juvenile proceeding. Specifically, petitioner seeks a writ of mandamus or prohibition requiring the respondent district court to accept petitioner's admission without requiring petitioner to divulge the name of the person with whom he used the controlled substance. Additionally, petitioner seeks a stay of all proceedings in the court below pending resolution of this petition.

We have considered the petition on file herein, and we are not satisfied that this court's intervention by way of extraordinary writ is warranted at this time. Accordingly, we deny the petition. See NRAP 21(b). Further, we deny petitioner's motion for a stay of proceedings.
