ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL

This is a proper person appeal from a default judgment in a forfeiture action. On April 11, 2001, we directed appellant to pay the filing fee required by NRS 2.250, or alternatively, to submit a proper motion for leave to proceed in forma pauperis to the district court under NRAP 24(a) within ten days. In response, appellant submitted a motion for an extension of time in which to file a motion under NRAP 24(a) in the district court. Appellant stated that he needed additional time to comply because he was housed in a detention center in Oklahoma. On June 1, 2001, we granted the motion, and allowed appellant thirty days to submit a proper motion for leave to proceed in forma pauperis to the district court, in compliance with NRAP 24(a), and to submit a file-stamped copy of the motion to this court. We cautioned appellant that failure to comply with our order might result in the dismissal of this appeal for failing to either pay the filing fee or secure leave to proceed on appeal in forma pauperis.

To date, appellant has failed to comply or otherwise respond to this court's June 1, 2001 order. Consequently, we conclude that appellant has abandoned this appeal, and we

ORDER this appeal DISMISSED.
