ORDER DENYING PETITION

This is an original proper person petition challenging petitioner's after-hours exclusion from the Nevada Supreme Court's Law Library. Although the proper method for challenging the revocation of library privileges is by letter to this court's Chief Justice, rather than by formal petition against this court's law librarian, we have considered the petition, and we conclude that the after-hours exclusion is warranted.¹ Accordingly, we deny the petition.²
