ORDER DENYING PETITION

This original petition for a writ of mandamus challenges the Governor's March 12, 2020, Declaration of Emergency for Covid-19. Court, 107 Nev. 674, 677, 679, 818 P.2d 849, 851, 853 (1991) (recognizing that writ relief is an extraordinary remedy and that this court has sole discretion in determining whether to entertain a writ petition).
