ORDER DENYING PETITION

This petition for a writ of mandamus and prohibition seeks an order directing respondent District Judge Sally L. Loehrer to conduct a hearing to preliminarily certify petitioner before adjudicating him as an adult, and to not enforce the State's "certification of [petitioner] . . . as an adult based solely on the . . . charges" filed against petitioner. We have considered the petition and answer on file herein, and we are not satisfied that this court's

intervention by way of extraordinary writ is warranted at this time.¹ Accordingly, we

ORDER the petition DENIED.²
