

ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL


This is an appeal from a district court order denying a motion for a preliminary injunction in district court case number CV16235. On June 1, 2001, respondents filed in this court an original petition for a writ of mandamus challenging a separate district court order denying their motion to dismiss Nye County's complaint on grounds of sovereign immunity and collateral estoppel. On March 28, 2002, we granted the petition and directed the district court in case number CV16235 to grant

respondents' motion to dismiss.<sup>1</sup> In light of that disposition, this appeal is moot. Accordingly, we hereby

ORDER this appeal DISMISSED.<sup>2</sup>
