This is an appeal from a final divorce decree awarding primary physical custody of the parties' minor children to respondent Mark Ben Sodrok.


Appellant Judith Leann Sodrok contends that the district court abused its discretion in awarding primary physical custody of the parties' minor children to Mark because it failed to consider several facts in reaching its decision. We disagree. After reviewing the record, we are satisfied that the district court properly considered the children's best interests, and we conclude that the district court's determination is supported by substantial evidence.¹


Accordingly, we
