ORDER DISMISSING APPEALS

These are pro se appeals from a district court order denying a motion to modify sentence. This court's review of these appeals reveals a jurisdictional defect. State*, 110 Nev. 349, 352, 871 P.2d 944, 946 (1994), this court lacks jurisdiction to consider these appeals, and
