

## ORDER DENYING PETITION

This is an original petition for a writ of mandamus. It challenges the district court's issuance of a warrant of execution for petitioner effective April 16 through April 22, 2001. Petitioner asks this court for a writ of mandamus directing the district court to reset his execution for the week beginning April 9, 2001. We conclude that petitioner has demonstrated no basis for this court to provide such relief.<sup>1</sup>

It appears that petitioner's execution date has been set according to law. Petitioner does not show that the district court failed to perform any act which the law requires of it or exercised its discretion arbitrarily or

capriciously.<sup>2</sup> Furthermore, sound judicial administration militates against the granting of petitioner's request.<sup>3</sup>
