ORDER DENYING PETITION FOR WRIT OF MANDAMUS

In this original petition for a writ of mandamus, proper person petitioner Eric Zessman challenges a district court order denying his motion for summary judgment. We have considered this petition, and we are not satisfied that this court's intervention by way of extraordinary relief is warranted at this time. As a policy, this court will not consider writ petitions that challenge an order denying a motion for summary judgment, except in those rare cases when clear authority required dismissal, or when an important question of law needs clarification.¹ This petition fits neither exception. Accordingly, we

ORDER this petition DENIED.²
