FOR WRIT OF HABEAS CORPUS


This is a proper person petition for a writ of habeas corpus. Petitioner is claiming that the Lyon County District Court did not have jurisdiction to convict him because the crime occurred in Washoe County. Thus, he claims that his judgment of conviction is null and void.
