On June 5, 2002, appellant filed a motion for an extension of time to comply with the procedures for remand set forth in Huneycutt v. Huneycutt, 94 Nev. 79, 575 P.2d 585 (1978). Cause appearing, we grant the motion. The clerk of this court shall file appellant's motion for remand, received on June 24, 2002.

Appellant's motion for remand seeks an order remanding this matter to the district court for entry of an order consistent with the terms of the parties' settlement agreement. The motion is accompanied by an order of the district court certifying that upon remand it is inclined to grant the parties' requested relief and enter an order consistent with terms of the parties' settlement agreement. Id.

Cause appearing, we grant appellant's motion. Accordingly, we remand this matter to the district court pursuant to its certification, and we order this appeal dismissed. NRAP 42(b).
