ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL AND REMANDING TO THE DISTRICT COURT

On June 5, 2002, appellant filed a motion for an extension of time to comply with the procedures for remand set forth in <u>Huneycutt v.</u> <u>Huneycutt</u>, 94 Nev. 79, 575 P.2d 585 (1978). Cause appearing, we grant the motion. The clerk of this court shall file appellant's motion for remand, received on June 24, 2002.

Appellant's motion for remand seeks an order remanding this matter to the district court for entry of an order consistent with the terms of the parties' settlement agreement.
