
ORDER DISMISSING APPEALS

These appeals were docketed in this court on May 11, 2001. Appellants Sherwin B. Beiser, Edward Gangloff, Bernard Merritt and Sandra Merritt have filed motions to dismiss these appeals, stating that they were erroneously filed in this court. Appellants state that they

intended to appeal to the Eighth Judicial District Court from a receivership's objection to a proof of claim, but that their notices of appeal were erroneously forwarded to this court.

A receiver's notice of objection to a claim is properly appealed to the district court. See NRS 78.685 (stating that "every creditor or claimant who has received notice from the receiver or trustee that his claim has been disallowed in whole or in part may appeal to the district court."). Accordingly, cause appearing, we grant appellants' motions and we dismiss these appeals.

It is so ORDERED.
