ORDER OF TRANSFER TO DISABILITY INACTIVE STATUS

Bar Counsel for the State Bar of Nevada and attorney Sheldon Markel have jointly petitioned this court for an order transferring Markel to disability inactive status. The parties have stipulated that Markel is presently incapacitated under the terms of SCR 117 from continuing to practice law.

Having reviewed the petition and its attachments, we conclude that the relief requested in the joint petition is warranted under the circumstances. Accordingly, Sheldon Markel is hereby transferred to disability inactive status. Markel may resume the active practice of law only after he has complied with SCR 117(6) and (7).

The State Bar shall effect such notice of this order as is required under the provisions of SCR 117(4) and (5). Bar counsel shall provide this court with proof of service of such notice.

It is so ORDERED.<sup>1</sup>
