ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL

This is a pro se notice of appeal from a district court order striking a postconviction petition for a writ of habeas corpus, striking a motion for bail, striking an application for appointment of counsel, striking a motion to modify, and denying a motion for stay.

Appellant's documents were stricken as fugitive documents because they were filed pro se at a time when he was represented by counsel in district court, and thus only permitted to proceed through counsel. Because no statute or court rule permits an appeal from an order striking fugitive documents and denying motion for stay, this court lacks jurisdiction to consider this appeal. Castillo v. State, 106 Nev. 349, 352, 792 P.2d 1133, 1135 (1990) (explaining that court has jurisdiction only when statute or court rule provides for appeal). Accordingly, this court

ORDERS this appeal DISMISSED.
