ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL

This is an appeal from an order of the district court dismissing an appeal from the justice court. Our review of this appeal revealed a potential jurisdictional defect. Specifically, appellants' case arose in the justice court. The district court has final appellate jurisdiction over a case arising in the justice court.¹ Accordingly, counsel for appellants was ordered to show cause why this appeal should not be dismissed for lack of jurisdiction.
