



ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL

This is an appeal from a district court order denying a motion to modify or correct an illegal sentence. Second Judicial District Court, Washoe County; Lynne K. Simons, Judge.

This court's review of this appeal reveals a jurisdictional defect. Specifically, the district court entered the order denying appellant's motion on February 21, 2023. Appellant did not file the notice of appeal, however, until June 15, 2023, well after the expiration of the 30-day appeal period prescribed by NRAP 4(b). *Lozada v. State*, 110 Nev. 349, 352, 871 P.2d 944, 946 (1994) (explaining that an untimely notice of appeal fails to vest jurisdiction in this court). Accordingly, this court

ORDERS this appeal DISMISSED.
