*ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL*

This is an appeal from a purported October 6, 2023, district court order denying a motion to vacate judgment of conviction. Eighth Judicial District Court, Clark County; Erika D. Ballou, Judge.

This court's review of this appeal reveals a jurisdictional defect. Specifically, no decision, oral or written, had been made on the motion when appellant filed his appeal on October 25, 2023. Rather, on October 6, 2023, the district court stated in a minute order that it would review the pleadings associated with the motion. Thus, the notice of appeal is premature. See NRS 177.015(3) (stating that a defendant may only appeal from a final judgment or verdict). Accordingly, this court lacks jurisdiction to consider this appeal and

ORDERS this appeal DISMISSED.
