ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL

This is a pro se appeal from a final judgment denying a petition to establish nonparent visitation after resolution of a timely tolling motion. Eighth Judicial District Court, Family Division, Clark County; Stephanie Charter, Judge.

On June 27, 2024, this court issued a notice directing appellant to, among other things, file and serve, by October 28, 2024, either (1) a brief that complies with the requirements in NRAP 28(a) and NRAP 32, or (2) the "Informal Brief Form for Pro Se Parties" provided by the clerk. The notice cautioned appellant that failure to timely file the opening brief or informal brief by the deadline may result in the dismissal of this appeal. NRAP 31(d).

When appellant failed to file the opening brief or informal brief, this court issued an order on November 7, 2024, noting that appellant's opening brief or informal brief was overdue and directing appellant to file the opening brief or informal brief within 7 days. The order also cautioned appellant that failure to timely file the opening brief or informal brief may result in the dismissal of this appeal. NRAP 31(d). To date, appellant has failed to file the opening brief or informal brief or otherwise communicate

with this court. Accordingly, it appears that appellant has abandoned this appeal and this court

ORDERS this appeal DISMISSED.
