



*ORDER DENYING PETITION  
FOR WRIT OF MANDAMUS OR PROHIBITION*

This is a pro se emergency petition for a writ of mandamus or prohibition challenging the Ex Officio Office of Las Vegas Constable as unconstitutional, among other related matters.<sup>1</sup> Appellant also seeks an emergency stay of eviction.

A writ of mandamus is available to compel the performance of an act that the law requires as a duty resulting from an office, trust, or station or to control an arbitrary or capricious exercise of discretion. See NRS 34.160; *Int'l Game Tech., Inc. v. Second Jud. Dist. Ct.*, 124 Nev. 193, 197, 179 P.3d 556, 558 (2008). A writ of prohibition may curb acts undertaken without or in excess of jurisdiction. NRS 34.320. Whether a



petition for extraordinary writ relief will be entertained rests within this court's sound discretion. *D.R. Horton, Inc. v. Eighth Jud. Dist. Ct.*, 123 Nev. 468, 474-75, 168 P.3d 731, 736-37 (2007). Petitioner bears the burden to show that extraordinary relief is warranted. *See Pan v. Eighth Jud. Dist. Ct.*, 120 Nev. 222, 228, 88 P.3d 840, 844 (2004).

Having reviewed the petition, we conclude that our extraordinary intervention is not warranted. NRAP 21(b); *see generally Bonaventura v. Bd. of Cnty. Comm'rs*, No. 65898, 2015 WL 8187534 (Nev. Dec. 2, 2015). Additionally, petitioner has not submitted an appendix with the materials essential to understanding the petition. *See* NRAP 21(a)(4). Accordingly, we decline to further consider this petition and

ORDER the petition DENIED.<sup>2</sup>
