



*ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL*

This appeal was docketed on November 1, 2024. Because the notice of appeal was not accompanied by the required proof of service, *see* NRAP 3(d)(1) (providing the notice of appeal must be served on all parties to the district court action and must “contain an acknowledgment of service or proof of service that conforms to the requirements of [NRAP] 25(d)”), on November 1, 2024, this court issued a notice directing appellant to provide this court with the required proof of service within 14 days. The notice advised that failure to comply could result in the dismissal of this appeal. *See* NRAP 3(a)(2) (“An appellant’s failure to take any step other than the timely filing of a notice of appeal does not affect the validity of the appeal but is ground only for the court to act as it deems appropriate, including dismissing the appeal”). Appellant failed to comply.

On December 2, 2024, this court entered an order, directing appellant to file a proof of service of the notice of appeal by December 16, 2024. The order cautioned that failure to timely comply could result in the dismissal of this appeal. To date, appellant has failed to file a proof of

service of the notice of appeal or to otherwise communicate with this court.  
Accordingly, this appeal is dismissed.

It is so ORDERED.
