ORDER DENYING PETITION FOR WRIT OF MANDAMUS

This emergency original petition for a writ of mandamus challenges a district court order denying a motion to dismiss. Eighth Judicial District Court, Clark County; Mark R. Denton, Judge.

Having reviewed the petition and supporting documents, we conclude that petitioner has not met his burden of demonstrating that our extraordinary intervention is warranted in this matter. See Pan v. Eighth Jud. Dist. Ct., 120 Nev. 222, 228, 88 P.3d 840, 844 (2004) (observing that the petitioner bears the burden of showing that writ relief is warranted). Therefore, we decline to exercise our discretion to further consider this petition, Smith v. Eighth Jud. Dist. Ct., 107 Nev. 674, 677, 679, 818 P.2d 849, 851, 853 (1991) (recognizing that writ relief is an extraordinary remedy
