ORDER DENYING PETITION FOR A WRIT OF MANDAMUS

This original petition for a writ of mandamus challenges a district court order denying a motion to dismiss a complaint and a motion to strike a portion of a complaint in a professional negligence dispute. Having considered the petition and the supporting documentation, we are not persuaded that our extraordinary and discretionary intervention is warranted at this time. See Pan v. Eighth Jud. Dist. Ct., 120 Nev. 222, 228, 88 P.3d 840, 844 (2004) (observing that the party seeking writ relief bears

the burden of demonstrating such relief is warranted); Smith v. Eighth Jud. Dist. Ct., 107 Nev. 674, 677, 679, 818 P.2d 849, 851, 853 (1991) (recognizing that writ relief is an extraordinary remedy and this court has sole discretion in determining whether to entertain a writ petition). We generally decline to consider writ petitions challenging orders denying motions to dismiss, and we are not convinced that any exception to the general rule applies in this case. Int'l Game Tech. v. Second Jud. Dist. Ct., 124 Nev. 193, 197-98, 179 P.3d 556, 558-59 (2008) (discussing exceptions to the general rule). Accordingly, we

ORDER the petition DENIED.
