

ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL

This is a pro se appeal from a final judgment of dismissal. Eighth Judicial District Court, Clark County; Joanna Kishner, Judge.

On March 24, 2025, this court granted appellant's motion for an extension of time to file and serve an opening brief or informal brief. On April 10, 2025, appellant filed an informal brief. However, on the same date, this court entered an order striking the informal brief because it was deficient. The order directed appellant to correct the deficiency and re-file the corrected opening brief within 14 days and cautioned that failure to comply would result in the dismissal of this appeal. On April 21, 2025, appellant re-filed the informal brief. The informal brief was still deficient and was stricken as deficient by order of this court entered April 24, 2025. The order directed appellant to correct the deficiency and re-file the informal brief with a proof of service that conformed with the rules within 14 days and again cautioned that failure to comply would result in the dismissal of this appeal.
