




ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL


This is a pro se appeal from an August 5, 2025, district court order denying a motion to dismiss a third-party defendant.

Review of the notice of appeal and documents before this court reveals a jurisdictional defect. Specifically, the order challenged in the notice of appeal is not substantively appealable. *See Kirsch v. Traber*, 134 Nev. 163, 168, 414 P.3d 818, 822 (2018) (stating that an order denying a motion to dismiss is not appealable). Further, no other statute or court rule appears to authorize an appeal from an order denying a motion to dismiss. *See Brown v. MHC Stagecoach, LLC*, 129 Nev. 343, 345, 301 P.3d 850, 851 (2013) (“[This court] may only consider appeals authorized by statute or court rule.”). Accordingly, this court lacks jurisdiction, and we

ORDER this appeal DISMISSED.¹
