


*ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL*


This is a pro se appeal from “the denial of a ‘certified’ alternative writ/notice filed May 26, 2025 and denied July 16, 2025.” Eighth Judicial District Court, Clark County; Tara D. Clark Newberry, Judge.

Appellant’s notice of appeal fails to identify any decision of the district court. *See* NRAP 3(c)(1)(B). No documents were filed in the district court in the underlying matter on either May 26, 2025, or July 16, 2025. To the extent, if any, appellant’s notice of appeal can be construed as challenging the August 27, 2024, amended judgment of conviction, the notice of appeal is untimely. *Lozada v. State*, 110 Nev. 349, 352, 871 P.2d 944, 946 (1994) (explaining that an untimely notice of appeal fails to vest jurisdiction in this court). This court lacks jurisdiction and

ORDERS this appeal DISMISSED.
