ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL

This is an appeal initiated by the filing of a pro se notice of appeal. Eighth Judicial District Court, Clark County; Danielle K. Pieper, Judge.

Appellant filed the notice of appeal on March 17, 2026. This court's review of the notice of appeal reveals a jurisdictional defect. Specifically, the notice of appeal fails to identify any decisions of the district court. To the extent, if any, appellant's notice of appeal can be construed as challenging the December 16, 2025, district court written "Order Denying Motion," no statute or court rule permits an appeal from the aforementioned district court order. *See Castillo v. State*, 106 Nev. 349, 352, 792 P.2d 1133, 1135 (1990) (explaining that this court has jurisdiction only when statute or court rule provides for appeal); NRAP 3(c)(1)(B). This court lacks jurisdiction to consider this appeal and

ORDERS this appeal DISMISSED.
