






ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL

This appeal was initiated by the filing of a pro se notice of appeal. Eighth Judicial District Court, Clark County; Monica Trujillo, Judge.

Appellant filed the notice of appeal on March 17, 2026. This court's review of the notice of appeal reveals a jurisdictional defect. Specifically, the notice of appeal fails to identify any decisions of the district court, and no order to which the notice of appeal could apply appears on the docket. *See Castillo v. State*, 106 Nev. 349, 352, 792 P.2d 1133, 1135 (1990) (explaining that this court has jurisdiction only when statute or court rule provides for appeal); NRAP 3(c)(1)(B). This court lacks jurisdiction to consider this appeal and

ORDERS this appeal DISMISSED.
