

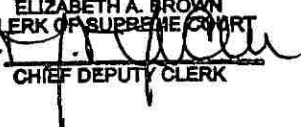

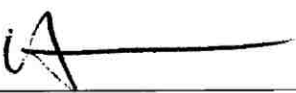
ORDER OF TRANSFER TO DISABILITY INACTIVE STATUS

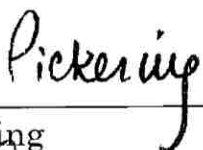
The Southern Nevada Disciplinary Board filed a petition under SCR 117(2) to determine the competency of attorney Ty M. Maynarich, based on concerns that he may be suffering from a disability due to mental infirmity, illness, or addiction such that he may presently lack the capacity to practice law. We referred the matter for a hearing and recommendation on competency. Thereafter, a disciplinary board hearing panel concluded that Maynarich is incapacitated for purposes of practicing law because of mental infirmity, illness, and/or addiction. The panel recommends that Maynarich be transferred to disability inactive status. Having reviewed the record, we agree with the hearing panel's recommendation.

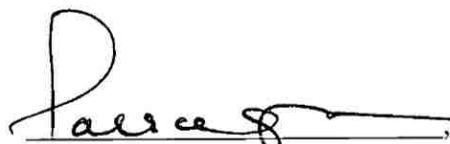
Accordingly, attorney Ty M. Maynarich is transferred to disability inactive status and any pending disciplinary proceeding against him is suspended pending further order of this court. As required by SCR 117(7), Maynarich shall comply with SCR 115. If he cannot, the Bar shall

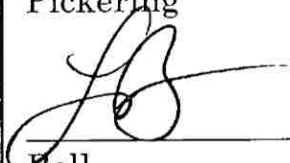
proceed under SCR 118. The Bar shall comply with SCR 121.1 and provide this court with proof that notice has been served.

It is so ORDERED.¹
