ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL

This is a pro se appeal of a district court order granting respondents' motion to dismiss appellant's complaint. Eighth Judicial District Court, Clark Co.; Hon. Michael Villani, Judge.

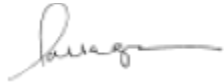
Review of the notice of appeal and documents before this court reveals a jurisdictional defect. Specifically, notice of entry of the challenged order was served electronically and by U.S. mail on April 14, 2026. Accordingly, appellant's notice of appeal was due to be filed in the district court by May 18, 2026, at the latest. NRAP 4(a)(1); NRAP 26(c); NRCP 6. Appellant did not file the notice of appeal until May 26, 2026, after the expiration of the 30-day appeal period prescribed by NRAP 4(a)(1). This court lacks jurisdiction to consider an untimely appeal. *See Healy v. Volkswagenwerk Aktiengesellschaft*, 103 Nev. 329, 331, 741 P.2d 432, 433 (1987) (explaining that

an untimely notice of appeal fails to vest jurisdiction in this court).
Accordingly, we

ORDER this appeal DISMISSED.
