ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL

This is a pro se appeal from a district court order awarding attorney fees. Eighth Judicial District Court, Family Division, Clark County; Michele Mercer, Judge.

Review of the notice of appeal and documents before this court reveals a jurisdictional defect. This court “may only consider appeals authorized by statute or court rule.” *Brown v. MHC Stagecoach, LLC*, 129 Nev. 343, 345, 301 P.3d 850, 851 (2013). No statute or court rule permits an independent appeal from the challenged order.

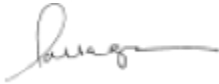
Appellant indicates in her notice of appeal that the order constitutes a post-judgment award of attorney fees because it was recorded on May 20, 2026. However, the order was entered on November 1, 2025, before entry of the final judgment (the decree of divorce) on March 13, 2026. See NRCP 58(c) (providing that a judgment is entered when it is signed by the court and filed with the clerk). The November 1 order is an interlocutory order that is not independently appealable. See *Consol. Generator-Nevada, Inc. v. Cummins Engine Co.*, 114 Nev. 1304, 1312, 971 P.2d 1251, 1256 (1998) (orders entered prior to the final judgment are interlocutory orders that are not independently appealable). Although the November 1 order was recorded after entry of the decree, the date of recordation is not relevant

to the jurisdictional analysis in this case. Accordingly, this court lacks jurisdiction and dismisses this appeal. We note that the November 1 order is subject to review in the context of the appeal in Docket No. 92450-COA, challenging the decree of divorce. *See id.* (interlocutory orders are subject to review in the context of the appeal from the final judgment). Appellant may include any argument relating to the November 1 order in her fast track opening brief in that matter. Appellant's motion for extension of time is granted. The docketing statement and transcript request form were filed on July 8, 2026.

It is so ORDERED.
