ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL


On June 10, 2002, the parties stipulated to remand this appeal to the district court. On September 13, 2002, appellants filed a copy of an order of the district court certifying that upon remand it is inclined to grant the parties' requested relief. See Huneycutt v. Huneycutt, 94 Nev. 79, 575 P.2d 585 (1978). Appellants request that this appeal be remanded so that the district court "may proceed as set forth" in its certification order.

Cause appearing, we approve the parties' stipulation. Accordingly, we remand this matter to the district court pursuant to its certification, and we dismiss this appeal. NRAP 42(b).
