
ORDER DENYING PETITION

This original petition for a writ of mandamus seeks an order of this court directing the Judges of the First Judicial District Court to issue a grand jury report. Having reviewed the petition, we are not persuaded that this court's intervention by way of extraordinary relief is warranted at this time. In particular, we conclude that an appropriate request for release of the report should be submitted to respondents in the first instance. Should respondents deny the request, petitioner may then again seek this court's intervention by way of extraordinary writ, and petitioner can provide this court with a record of the proceedings below necessary to an understanding of the issues presented.¹

Accordingly, we deny this petition without prejudice to petitioner's right to again seek this court's intervention after

respondents have been provided an opportunity to rule on an appropriate request in the first instance.

It is so ORDERED.
