ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL

This is a proper person appeal from a district court order establishing a temporary visitation schedule for respondent with the parties' minor child. Our review of the documentation before us reveals a jurisdictional defect. Specifically, a district court's order that is not final is not an appealable order because it is subject to review and modification by the district court.¹ Thus, no appeal may be taken from a temporary visitation order.

Accordingly, as we lack jurisdiction, we
ORDER this appeal DISMISSED.
