## **ORDER OF REMAND**



This is an appeal from a judgment of conviction, pursuant to a plea of guilty, of one count of exploitation of a person over the age of 60 years, and one count of neglect of a person over the age of 60 years. The appeal is subject to the criminal fast track provisions of NRAP 3C.

On August 15, 2003, the parties to this appeal filed a stipulation to remand this appeal to the district court, so that the district court can amend the judgment of conviction. Attached to the stipulation is an order of the district court certifying that it is inclined to grant the State's motion to amend the judgment of conviction.

Cause appearing, the stipulation is approved, and we remand this matter to the district court for further proceedings. This order constitutes this court's final disposition of this appeal. Upon entry of an amended judgment of conviction, appellant may file a new notice of appeal.
