ORDER DISMISSING PETITION FOR
WRIT OF MANDAMUS OR PROHIBITION

This original petition for a writ of mandamus or prohibition seeks to compel the district court to dismiss the underlying Nevada divorce case in light of a simultaneous California divorce proceeding. On September 23, 2002, we ordered an answer. Subsequently, petitioner and real party in interest filed, in the Nevada district court, a joint stipulation to dismiss the divorce complaint. On October 24, 2002, the district court entered an order approving the parties' stipulation to dismiss. On October 31, 2002, petitioner filed a motion in this court to dismiss the petition for a writ of mandamus or prohibition. We grant the motion and dismiss this petition.
