This is an appeal from a judgment of conviction. Our review of this appeal indicates that the district court entered the judgment of conviction on May 15, 2002. Appellant did not file the notice of appeal, however, until June 25, 2002, after the expiration of the thirty-day appeal period prescribed by NRAP 4(b). An untimely notice of appeal fails to vest jurisdiction in this court.¹ Accordingly, we conclude that we lack jurisdiction to consider this appeal, and we
