ORDER DENYING PETITION

This is a proper person post-conviction petition for a writ of habeas corpus challenging the validity of petitioner's judgment of conviction and sentence. We have considered the petition on file herein, and we are not satisfied that this court's intervention by way of extraordinary relief is warranted at this time. Any challenge to the validity of a conviction and sentence should be raised in a post-conviction petition for a writ of habeas corpus filed in the district court in the first instance.<sup>1</sup> Petitioner may then appeal to this court from an adverse decision.<sup>2</sup> Accordingly, we
