ORDER OF TRANSFER TO DISABILITY INACTIVE STATUS


Bar Counsel for the State Bar of Nevada and attorney Roger C. Molett have jointly petitioned this court for an order transferring Molett to disability inactive status. The parties have stipulated that Molett is presently incapacitated under the terms of SCR 117 from continuing to practice law.

Having reviewed the petition and its attachments, we conclude that the relief requested in the joint petition is warranted under the circumstances. Accordingly, Roger C. Molett is hereby transferred to disability inactive status. Molett may resume the active practice of law only after he has complied with SCR 117(6) and (7), and has paid restitution in the form of refunds of legal fees paid by his former clients, but not earned by Molett.


The State Bar shall effect such notice of this order as is required under the provisions of SCR 117(4) and (5). Bar counsel shall provide this court with proof of service of such notice.


It is so ORDERED.




