ORDER DENYING MOTION TO CONSOLIDATE  
AND ADMINISTRATIVELY CLOSING APPEAL

These are appeals from a judgment of conviction, pursuant to a guilty plea, of one count of attempted robbery and one count of attempted first degree kidnapping. Appellant filed a proper person notice of appeal from the judgment of conviction, which was docketed in this court as Docket No. 39968. Appellant subsequently filed a second notice of appeal from the judgment of conviction specifically challenging the amount of restitution. That appeal was docketed in this court as Docket No. 39995. Because these appeals challenge a single judgment of conviction, the clerk of this court is hereby directed to administratively close Docket No. 39995. In light of this order, appellant's motion to consolidate these appeals is denied as moot.
