ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL

On August 8, 2002, the clerk of this court issued a notice to appellant to pay the filing fee within 10 days. See NRS2.250(1)(a) and NRAP 3(f). Because appellant had not yet paid the filing fee, on September 11, 2002, this court entered an order directing appellant to pay the filing fee within 10 days. On October 23, 2002, the parties filed a stipulation to dismiss this appeal. Because appellant still had not paid the filing fee, on November 4, 2002, this court entered an order defering on ruling on the parties' stipulation and directing appellant to pay the filing fee within 10 days. That order explained that an appeal cannot be dismissed until the parties first "pay whatever fees are due." See NRAP 42(b).

To date, appellant has failed to pay the filing fee or otherwise respond to our November 4, 2002, order. Appellant shall pay the \$200 filing fee within 10 days from the date of this order. We caution appellant that failure to pay the filing fee in a timely manner will result in the imposition of sanctions.

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As noted above, under NRAP 42(b), an appeal shall not be dismissed until the parties first "pay whatever fees are due." Nevertheless, because we do not wish to delay the dismissal of this appeal any longer, we approve the parties' stipulation and dismiss this appeal. Each party shall bear their own fees and costs. NRAP 42(b).

It is so ORDERED.
