


ORDER DISMISSING PETITION FOR
WRIT OF MANDAMUS OR PROHIBITION


This original petition for a writ of mandamus or prohibition challenges a district court order that certified as a class action the lawsuit filed by the real parties in interest. After receiving an answer from the real parties, we ordered petitioner on March 5 and March 31, 2003, to show cause why this writ petition should not be dismissed as moot. On April 10, 2003, petitioner and the real parties filed a stipulation to dismiss the writ petition as moot in light of the parties' pending "settlement of all issues in the case."

Accordingly, we approve the stipulation and we dismiss this writ petition. The parties shall bear their own costs and attorney fees.¹

It is so ORDERED.
