

ORDER DENYING PETITION


This is a proper person petition for a writ of mandamus seeking an order compelling the district court to consider and rule upon petitioner's post-conviction petition for a writ of habeas corpus, two supplements to the petition, thirteen motions, and two applications for a preliminary injunction. Petitioner also seeks an order compelling the district court to conduct an in camera review of the State's evidence. We have considered the petition on file herein, and we are not satisfied that this court's intervention by way of extraordinary relief is warranted at this
