ORDER DENYING PETITION

This is a proper person petition for a writ of mandamus requesting that the respondents be ordered to: (1) compel expert examination of a taped-statement, (2) compel trial counsel to reveal to petitioner the identity of co-counsel, (3) compel the State to comply with the request for exculpatory evidence, (4) compel examination of evidence by an independent pathology expert, (5) compel investigative compulsory process to obtain favorable witnesses and experts for the defense, and (6) compel counsel to provide a brief on petitioner's interlocutory appeal. We have considered the petition on file herein, and we are not satisfied that this court's intervention by way of extraordinary relief is warranted at this time.¹ Because petitioner is represented by trial counsel, petitioner should




address all concerns relating to the trial proceedings to trial counsel.
