ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL

This is a proper person appeal from an order of the district court revoking appellant's probation. Our review of this appeal indicates that the district court entered the order revoking probation on October 31, 2002. Appellant did not file the notice of appeal, however, until December 18, 2002, well after the expiration of the thirty-day appeal period prescribed by NRAP 4(b). An untimely notice of appeal fails to vest jurisdiction in this court.¹ Accordingly, we conclude that we lack jurisdiction to consider this appeal, and we

ORDER this appeal DISMISSED.
